Angelo was elected to the Schenectady County Legislature in 2007 and reelected in 2011, where he represented District 4, which includes the Towns of Rotterdam, Princetown and Duanesburg. He served as Chairman of the Transportation Committee and Vice

Chairman of the Veterans Committee. He held public office as a Schenectady County Legislator for five years before being elected to the New York State Assembly in 2012 as the first Assemblyman to represent the newly created 111th District, which includes Montgomery County, and parts of Schenectady and Albany Counties. He was reelected to a second term in 2014 and third term in 2016. As a member of the New York State Assembly he serves as Chairman of the Sub-Committee on Autism Spectrum Disorders and as a member of the Agriculture, Energy, Governmental Employees, Mental Health, Racing & Wagering, and Veterans' Affairs Committees. Angelo produces several ongoing programs on Open Stage Media and is a strong supporter of community media.
